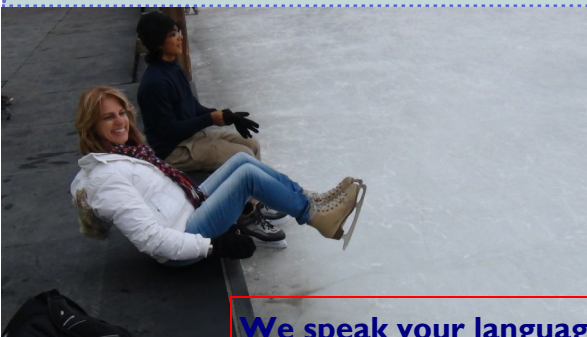




Experience Winter in Toronto: Ice Skating
